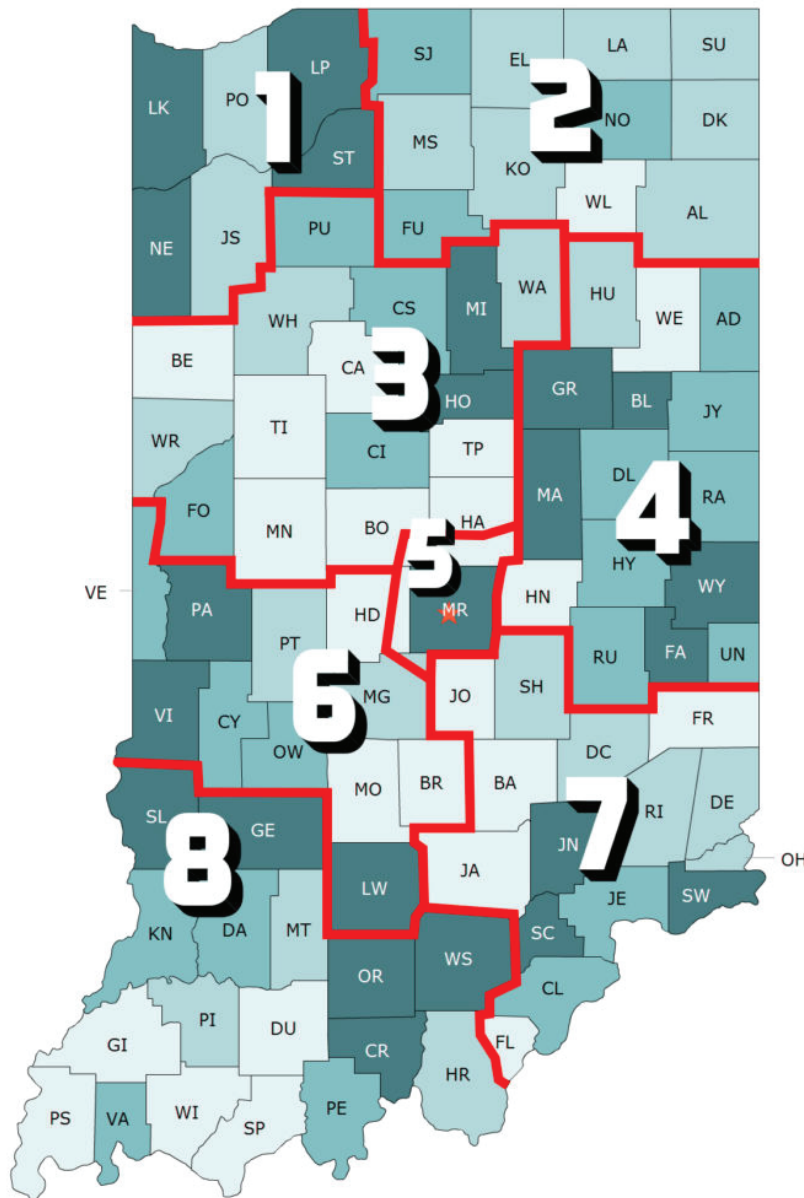

Furthermore, the 2023 SOC offering for the Indiana District was the 5th largest District offering in North America. To God be the Glory!

-Junior Bible Quizzing-Bro. Eric Fisher continues to do a fantastic job as Indiana's JBQ Director and we are excited for what is happening this JBQ season! We had a record number of teams that quizzed in 2023 and one of the Indiana teams was the National Champion!

-Modern Day Knights-There is such a strong need for programs to help young boys learn to become men in today's society. We have successfully hosted six Modern Day Knights events. It is a one-day event held in the fall each year. We have various speakers and focus on three main areas with the boys: Honor, Courage and Integrity.

-Children's Camps-We had a tremendous time last summer during our kids camps. We had over 380 registered campers both week and over both camps, we had 55 children were filled with the Holy Ghost for the first time!

-Indiana Children's Ministries Endowment-We are excited to announce that we have successfully started an Indiana Children's Ministries Endowment through the Stewardship Department of the UPCI. We invested \$5,000 last year and had a church match that amount. 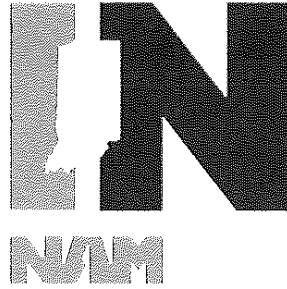

Year in Review

In 2023, 37 churches in Indiana hosted 76 missionary services with a total district-wide giving of \$1,970,119.48, placing Indiana fourth in missions giving in the entire UPCI. Let me share with you the potential impact cultural groups can have upon our local congregations as we attempt to reach every culture group that God has brought into our harvest field.

According to Indiana's population statistics, 378,953, or 5.6% of the state's population, are immigrants. Immigrants make up 1 in 14 workers in Indiana and support the local economy in many ways. They account for 9.0 percent of entrepreneurs, 12.4 percent of STEM workers, and 22.6 percent of physicians in the state. As neighbors, business owners, taxpayers, and workers, immigrants are integral to Indiana's diverse and thriving communities and make extensive contributions that benefit all.

They represent 10.1 billion dollars in spending power, of which they paid 3.4 billion in taxes last year. Within this group, 25.1% are from Mexico, 7.1% are from India, 4.6% are from Burma, 4.4% are from China, and 3.4% are from the Philippines.

Within the Indy metro area, there are people from 68 different nations. Truly, God has brought the mission field to our backyard.

Multicultural Ministries has several resources available to help you "see" the harvest, "find" the harvest, and "reap" the harvest that God has brought to every small town and large city in Indiana.

One resource is GlobalTracks.com, which has a vast database of doctrinal books, Bible studies, and teaching materials in multiple languages that are available to download for free as tools for evangelism and discipleship.

Greetings Ministers of Indiana

Since our last district conference my role has transferred from Youth Promotions Director to Youth Evangelism Coordinator for Indiana Youth. It was an honor to serve as the Promotions Director, which was a newly created role at my time of appointment. During our last Youth Planning Meeting our team expressed the need for someone to oversee the areas of Youth Evangelism in our state. I am now thrilled to step into this newly created role for Indiana Youth. This position oversees P7 (Project 7 Bible/Prayer Clubs in Schools) as well as CMI (Campus Ministry International). All emphasis is on our Youth and Hyphen reaching and winning their world for the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In my short time in this position, we have made an assessment of the current state of P7s and CMIs in the state and section. In Indiana, we have **29 active P7 Groups**.
