



INDIANA CAMP PACKING CHECKLIST/ DAILY SCHEDULE

BEDDING CHECKLIST

- Twin Sized Bunks are provided for all students
- It's best to bring Twin Sheets, fitted, and a regular twin sheet
- You will need a pillow
- Make sure you have a blanket or sleeping bag for your bed, it can get cold at night

SHOWER CHECKLIST

- Soap (body/hair)
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Hair Styling Stuff
- Make sure to bring a few towels

DAILY SCHEDULE

- Morning Service (Casual)
- Afternoon (Recreational Clothes)
- Evening Service (Business Casual/ Dress Clothes)
- After-Service Recreation (Clothes you don't mind getting dirty/ruined)
 - Sunday School Camp has a water/ shaving cream fight
 - A Dirty Clothes Hamper or Trash Bag would be helpful

FOOD

- 3 Meals are served every day, starting with Monday Night's Dinner @4:30PM
- A Snack Bar is provided after service
 - Items are usually \$5-\$10

SNACKS

- An Ice Cream bar is available during the day
 - Extra money is required for this
- A Snack Bar is provided after service
 - Items are usually \$5-\$10

SPENDING MONEY

- \$5-\$10 is needed if you want to purchase snacks
- For younger campers- money can be stored and given to the dorm supervisors to distribute every day
